This seminar is being held to formally launch the Industry Guideline which has been under development within the paper industry over the past four years. The Guideline aims to fill the gap which exists in current European legislation by offering better certainty of compliance with consumer safety requirements. This will show benefits both for the industry and its customers. The Guideline has been peer reviewed by a leading international institute who found that it was of a high standard and the only measure in existence to contain all elements required to establish compliance with Regulation (EC) 1935/2004.

This seminar is being held in order to communicate details about the content and implementation of the Guideline within the paper manufacturing and converting sector before it is launched to the wider audience containing the food industry and legislators. Information also will be given about a new Good Manufacturing Practice which is due for publication in the first half of 2010 and will complement the Guideline.

These will include company personnel involved in sales, technical, product safety, marketing and customer service as well as staff from affected trade associations.
