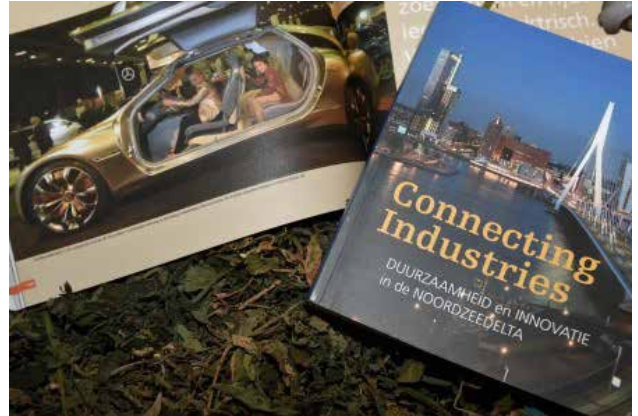

PAPER MADE WITH FIBRES FROM LOCAL AGRICULTURAL HORTICULTURE

After two years of development, Schut Paper launched Valorise. This paper is the result of collaboration with growers, knowledge centres and universities for the circular value of fibres from agricultural residues such as tomato plants. The optimal scenario is that agricultural residue (e.g. tomato and pepper crops) is not composted, but that 100% is used as raw material for the paper sector and as an ingredient for other industries. The processing of these agricultural fibres and the unique formula of Schut Paper has produced a very attractive paper with high tactile and visual value, in which the fibres have a very subtle presence.
