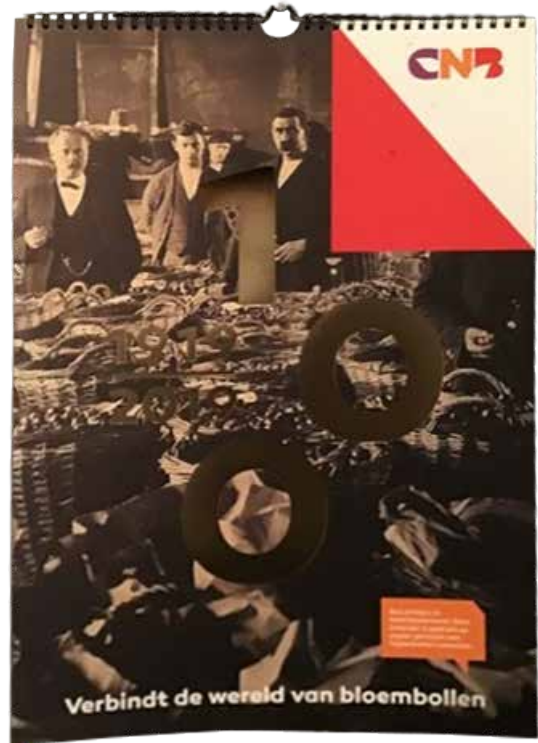

## PAPER MADE WITH FIBRES FROM TULIP BULBS

After one year of development, Schut Paper launched, together with a grower in Northwest Netherlands a paper and board made with 20% tulip bulbs. This paper is the result of collaboration with a grower, his customer and the people of the laboratory at Schut Papier. Previously, the overproduction of a very special tulip bulb was destroyed because these bulbs were supposed to be sold only to a certain customer in the USA. Nowadays, the tulips are refined and mixed with FSC cellulose. The tulip bulbs are 100% used as raw material for this paper. The processing of these agricultural fibres and the unique formula of Schut Papier has produced a very attractive paper with high tactile and visual value, in which the fibres have a subtle presence.
